- ▶ Ahead of new developments

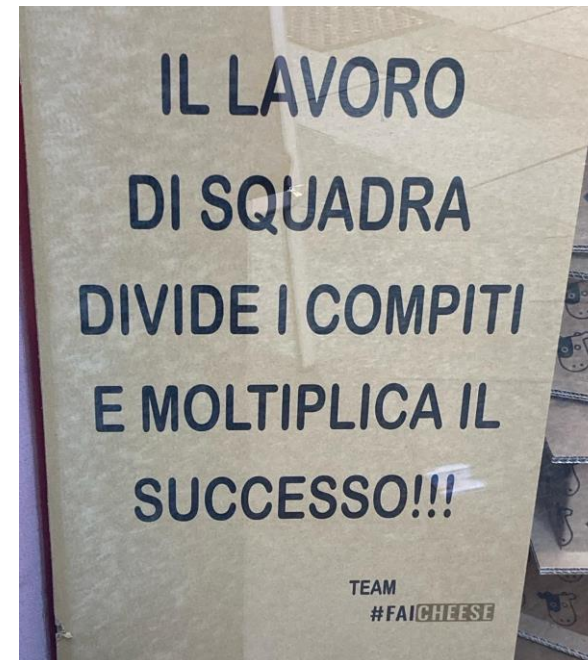
Cons
